<b>課程資訊</b>	
<b>課程概述</b>	<p>Besides providing language training, the course aims to bring the students to the awareness that learning about culture (from literature and cinema) is indispensable when they learn a language and that language and culture constitute the imagination of a life style (to learn a language is exactly to learn about a way of living) and the understanding of the world. They conduce eventually to self-surpassing (creativity) on the personal level and cross-culture communication on the global level.</p>
<b>課程目標</b>	<p>To help students improve not just their English listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills through literature and cinema but their ability to appreciate western literature:</p> <p>I Listening : materials selected from a variety of sources such as TOEFL, GEPT, magazines, film scripts, etc.</p> <p>II Speaking : English presentation/drama/interview</p> <p>III Reading:</p> <p>A. materials on western literature</p> <p>2 Shakespeare’s comedy: “Much Ado About Nothing” (text, film, commentary)</p> <p>3 Romanticism: Wordsworth’s poetry (text, film: “A River Runs Through It”)</p> <p>4 Modernism: Marguerite Duras’ “The Lover” (text, film: “The Lover”, commentary) 5 Post-colonialism (commentary: “A Post-colonial Reading of François Cheng’s Novels”, film: “M. Butterfly”)</p> <p>B. Vocabulary: the textbook “Word Power made Easy”</p> <p>IV Writing : materials extracted from the book “Steps to Writing Well”</p>
<b>課程要求</b>	<p># 1 Final presentation or examination</p> <p>The students can either make a presentation with groupmates or take a written examination at the end of the semester.</p> <p>The final presentation can be done in the form of drama or interview. They can choose to stage an assigned play or show an interview with foreign students (American, British, French, or German students) on the campus.</p> <p>The interview will be conducted with a focus on cultural issues or with the purpose of knowing about the foreign interviewees’ needs and trying to give a hand. Of all the questions intended for them, there should be at least</p>

	<p>four questions related to the course content.</p> <p># 2 8-minute oral presentation</p> <p>The students will make an oral presentation on a topic of their own. Presentations should be done with Power Point. During a presentation, students can show video clips, but that cannot be longer than 2 minutes.</p> <p>It would be best for them to give their presentations from memory.</p> <p>The students will make an oral presentation on a topic of their own. In case they cannot come up with their own topic, they may refer to the following suggested topics:</p> <p>20th or 21st century inventions: architecture/medicine/technology/literature/art/fashion/social movements...</p>
